\$25 to \$100	Link Up	<p>Sponsor students and teachers who are participating in the Link Up Program. Symphony orchestras in Mississippi have become partners in the Carnegie Hall Link Up program, coordinated by the MAC. Offered to students in grades 4-5, the program encourages children to sing, compose, play the recorder, and more.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchase recorders for students in one classroom \$100 • Contribute to school district transportation costs to a concert \$25-50 • Purchase box lunches for teacher training workshop day to learn to prep students for the program (5 teachers) \$50
